HOPE ESTATE is an open-air grassed venue with both seated and general admission (non-seated) areas.

GETTING TO AND FROM THE CONCERT

WE STRONGLY RECOMMEND YOU CATCH THE BUS! The local road network can get extremely congested on event days. Buses generally depart the venue in under 30 minutes whereas cars can take much longer. For bus bookings go to: www.rovercoaches.com.au to book your seat.

Travelling from Sydney: Follow the F3 North moving onto the Hunter Expressway toward Singleton then take the Lovedale Rd exit and follow the signs to the Vineyards.

Travelling from Newcastle: Take the Newcastle Link Road onto Hunter Expressway and take the Lovedale Road exit. Follow to Pokolbin turning right onto Wine Country Drive then left onto Broke Road.

Box Office: Two box offices will operate on event day. One at the main entry gate to the concert arena, adjacent to the general public car park off Broke Road, and the secondary box office, available for bus patrons only, is located at the entry from the bus parking area. Patrons are encouraged to collect their tickets in advance from a Ticketek outlet visit www.ticketek.com.au

Cloakroom Facilities: Cloakroom facilities will not be available at the event. Prohibited items may be confiscated, and are unable to be stored. If in doubt leave it behind.

Food & Beverage: Hope Estate is a fully catered venue and is **STRICTLY NO BYO FOOD OR BEVERAGES** (including water). This will be enforced by security at the entry gates.

A range of food and beverages will be available for purchase on site. Visit hopeestate.com.au for details. Picnic Hampers are available for pre-purchase by calling 1800 777 444.

Free drinking water will be available in the venue and patrons may bring in empty, clear, reusable sports or camping drink containers. No glass allowed.

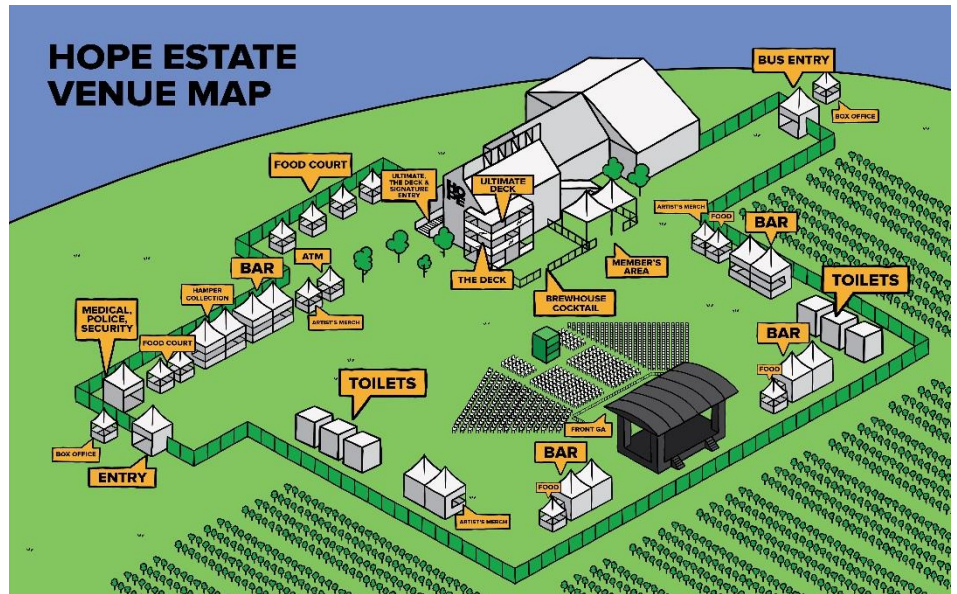
Photo ID will be required to purchase and consume alcohol and service will not be provided to people under 18 years of age. Please note that because Hope Estate is a licensed venue, patrons are unable to take bottles of wine from the site at the end of the night.

BOTTLED WINE WILL BE LIMITED TO 1 PER PERSON BY VOUCHER SYSTEM. VOUCHERS WILL BE ISSUED ON ENTRY AND CANNOT BE REISSUED IF LOST.

Smoking: Smoking is permitted in the designated smoking area only.

First Aid: Medical services will be in attendance.

ATM: Located near the main bar and Food Court. All bars and food stalls are cash only and will not have EFTPOS facilities. It is recommended that you come prepared with enough cash for your needs for the entire evening.



Police & Security: For your safety Security Guards, RSA Marshals and Police will be on-site. Should you require assistance please SMS 0428 260 477 with your location/seat #. The Police command station is located near the main gate with the medical facilities.

Bags: Will be subject to a search upon entry. Any person in possession of prohibited items may be refused entry to the site. If in doubt leave it at home or in the car.

Weather: The concert will proceed rain or shine. Only exceptionally severe weather conditions will affect the performance, so come prepared for either scenario.

Disabled Access & Parking: Free car parking is available on-site, it is located in greenfield areas and accessed from the Broke Road entrance. Disabled parking is available close to the main entry gate – to park in this area vehicles must have a valid disabled parking sticker displayed. Spaces are limited so please allow plenty of time to get to the venue to secure a spot. There is a pre-show drop-off point at the main entry. Please note this is available at the beginning of the concert only. Patrons cannot be collected from this point after the concert, as all vehicles will be exiting the venue. Please be aware that this is an outdoor venue with undulating hills so it may be necessary to attend the event with assistance.

Please note the opening time of the Car Park. If you arrive early you will be turned away.

VIP Parking is also available next to the main patron entrance off Broke Road. This is limited so please allow enough time to get to the venue to secure a parking space.

There is strictly no camping on-site and all patrons must depart the venue after the show.

There are no pass-outs during this show.

WHAT TO BRING

- Jacket or poncho for inclement weather (Umbrellas will not be allowed)
- Sunscreen and sun hat

- Comfortable shoes suitable for walking around the outdoor, grassed venue

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Chairs or cushions with backs of any kind, including inflatables.
- Bags or backpacks larger than an A4 sheet of paper
- Professional cameras, audio or video recording devices, iPads, Go-Pros, selfie-sticks or drones
- Umbrellas, tents & sunshades
- Glass containers of any kind
- Aluminium & metal containers (empty clear camping/sports type water bottles allowed)
- Drinks: Alcoholic or any other type of beverage
- Food
- Picnic baskets & eskies
- Illegal or illicit substances of any kind
- Musical instruments or air horns
- Prams
- Radio scanners/jamming equipment
- Poles, sticks, signs, banners or oversized flags (strictly prohibited)
- Confetti or shredded paper
- Laser pointers, fireworks, flares or explosives
- Animals (except for authorised assistance dogs)
- Balls, sporting equipment, bicycles, skateboards, skates or scooters
- Weapons or any other object which may be used as a missile or weapon
- Unopened packages
- Any other object that the promoter considers inappropriate or dangerous

HOPE ESTATE CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Persons may be refused entry for, but not limited to, the following:

- Any person deemed to be intoxicated and/or disorderly
- Any person who does not comply with a request to conduct a bag search
- Any person who does not comply with a request from the organizer, security or Police
- No unauthorised vendors allowed

Minors must remain in the company of a responsible adult at all times.
